HIGHLIGHTS FOR WINTER 2018

GIFT CERTIFICATES: The Winter Enrichment Session is the perfect opportunity for gift-giving over the upcoming Holiday season. If you would like a gift certificate, please contact Suzanne DeCoste and we can provide you with one!

SUGGESTED GRADE RANGES: A grade range is included in each course description. These are determined by the instructors based on their target audience. For some classes, instructors have allowed flexibility with these ranges to students who border the grade range, i.e. a 2nd grader may enroll in a class listed for grade 3. If your child is interested in a class and is in a bordering grade, contact us to see if the instructor will allow an exception. We have been able to include students in sessions when appropriate and space allows.

LIFE SKILLS WORKSHOPS: Spaces remain in several one-time workshops designed to provide social and safety education to SJE students. See pages 6 and 7 for more details on available workshops.

REMINDERS FOR WINTER 2018

FEES: Class fees vary due to instructor fees, material costs, and length of class. All students in the program must pay the \$15.00 registration fee. The registration fees cover program overhead and funds future online registration capabilities.

ENROLLMENT: Enrollment is first-come, first-served. Advance registration is required to plan class size and resources. Confirmations are sent once minimum enrollment is met. A wait list is started when the maximum number is reached.

AFTERCARE: The Enrichment Program is separate from the SJE Aftercare program. Both programs work together on seamless transitions for our families, but paperwork, fees, and forms are managed separately. Please keep this in mind when completing all paperwork and complete the Enrichment form in full.
