Internet safety is on the mind of every parent. It is estimated that 2 out of 3 households have a computer and access to the internet. What this also means is that there are risks involved: 26% of kids ages 9 -15 went to meet a friend that they met online without the permission of their parents. What that tells us is that kids either don't know the rules, or don't understand the seriousness of online safety. This Internet Safety workshop covers the topic of Internet safety through interactive, non-threatening and entertaining lessons.

Kids learn how to recognize warning signs, safe and unsafe situations, and the skills they need to make safe choices. Students will learn rules for safely using social networks; how to recognize warning signs from online predators; how to identify, avoid, and respond to cyber bullying; and how to get the most out of the internet while staying safe
