SJE Garden Club - Grades 2 - 8

With the installation of our outdoor spaces near completion, the focus of our partnership with Oak Knoll Wildlife Sanctuary shifts to the ongoing upkeep of and continual improvements to the Prayer and Learning Gardens. The Garden Club will meet throughout the year to tend to our spaces, focus on local resource management, and further develop opportunities to improve our ecological footprint. **Oak Knoll Wildlife Sanctuary; 15 sessions; Tuesdays, 2:00 – 3:30 PM. Cost = \$225.**

SJE Chess Club - Grades 1 - 8

The Chess Club offers a safe environment to learn abstract concepts and compete in an intellectual game. Chess teaches critical thinking, planning, logic and analysis. It improves the ability to concentrate and teaches the value of good sportsmanship. The year will end with a club tournament. Basketball Boot Camp – Session 1: Grades 3 – 5; Session 2: Grades 6 – 8

SocialSkiz: essential tweenz :-) – Grades 3 - 6

Equipping our children with tools to thrive in today’s modern world is a challenge. This program focuses on teaching “tweenz” valuable social and communication skills. Participants learn: How to Make a Good First Impression (mastering face-to-face interactions, handshakes, greetings and introductions); Being Independent (initiative, responsibility, organization, preparation, mindfulness, thoughtfulness and patience); Eat In, Dine Out (eating out, setting a table, utensil use, dinner conversations and expressing gratitude).
